Graduation Rates

As of July 1, 2017, the graduation rate for students who began their post-secondary training at Florida Technical College from September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2011, and for whom 150 percent of the normal time for program completion ended as of August 31, 2016, is as follows:

Of the 2342 students who began school 965 completed their course work within the allowed time frame. Therefore, Florida Technical College's graduation rate for those students is 41 percent.

Please see the next page for the percentages on gender, ethnicity, Pell Grant recipients, subsidized Stafford Loan recipients, and students who did not receive either a Pell Grant or a subsidized Stafford Loan.

Note:

1. There were no students who were given exclusion for having left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government, or for being deceased or permanently disabled.
2. Graduation rates include first-time, full-time students only. A first-time student is defined as a student who is entering college for the first time during that cohort period.
