**STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW INFORMATION DISCLOSURES (34 CFR 668.45)
JULY 1, 2019**

The federal **STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW ACT** requires that annually (no later than July 1) institutions of postsecondary education prepare and disseminate information about their graduation rates of full-time, first-time in undergraduate programs leading to a certificate, associate's or bachelor's degree. In addition, the institution must also provide information on:

- Graduation rates detailed by gender, by race as defined by the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS), by Pell Grant beneficiary, by beneficiary of a Direct Loan that did not receive Pell Grant, and by students who did not receive either Pell Grant or Direct Loan,
- Retention rates as reported to the IPEDS,
- Placement rates and types of employment obtained by graduates, and
- Types of graduate and professional education in which graduates of any institution's four-year degree programs have enrolled.

The source of the Placement Rates and Types of Employment provided in the chart above is from employment verifications completed by graduates or employers or employment records from the Work# database. The calculation of rates includes students who graduated from a program from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 (“Reporting Period”), were available for employment, and were employed before November 1, 2018, which is approximately four months after the end of the Reporting Period. The calculation of this rate does not include students who graduated from a program during the Reporting Period and were not available for employment due to pregnancy, death, or other health-related issues; continuing education; active military service; visa restrictions (international students); enrollment in an English as a Second Language (ESL) program; or incarceration. Employment is based upon job titles included in the list of job titles published by the institution for which the program prepares students; the required use of skills learned in the student’s program as a predominant component of the job; or the benefit of the training received from the program in obtaining a new position or maintaining a current position, supporting promotion or improving job related skills.

Placement rates are calculated as follows:

$$\frac{(\text{Placed by job title} + \text{Placed by skills} + \text{Placed by benefit of training})}{((\text{Graduates}) - (\text{Not Available for Employment}))}$$
