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Admission Requirements

- Proof of High School Diploma or recognized equivalent.
- At least 18 years of age at the time of enrollment.
- Schedule to take or provide a composite score of 68 [BSN] or higher on the Test of Essential Academic Skills [TEAS] nursing entrance examination (version 7) completed within the last 12 months.

Additional Requirements

- Acceptable background check and drug screening
- Director of Nursing Interview
- Proof of good physical and mental health
